on its tail



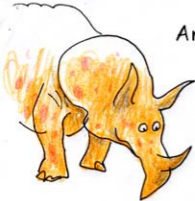
His uncle, the Stegosaurus, who had a brain the size of a walnut

In the end he didn't dare show himself



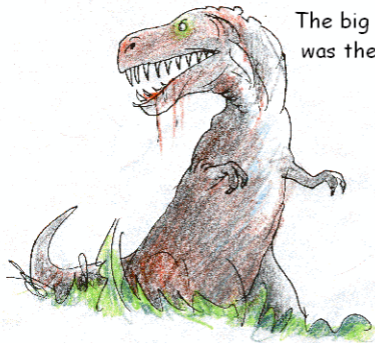
One day, in the great Jurassic forest terrible footsteps shook the ground

Then it chased away a female Protoceratops

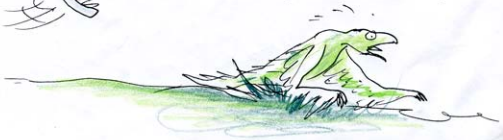
To feast on
her eggs



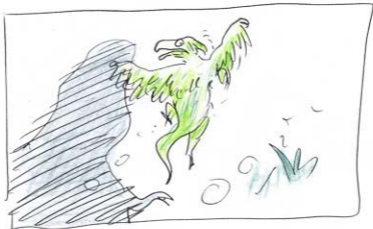
It was then that it spotted the little lizard, standing

The Tyrannosaurus' eyes were fixed on the poor animal and was already licking its lip

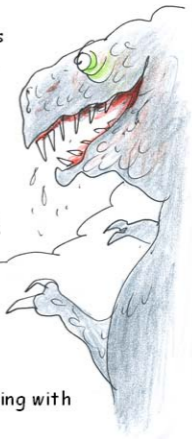
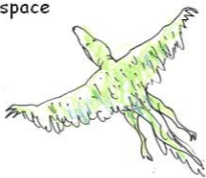


Neither one nor the other noticed that they were running towards a precipice

and leapt into space

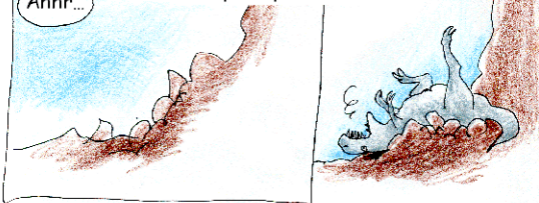


The Tyrannosaurus, its eyes glistening with

I'm flying...

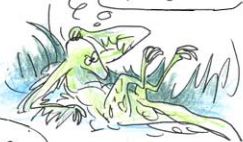




Not very precise yet but
